About the Company

About the Programme

Research has shown that the school holidays can be pressure points for some families. This can lead to children being less likely to access organised out-of-school activities and more likely to experience social isolation.

The government's Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme is a response to this issue, with evidence showing that free holiday clubs can have a positive impact on children by providing easily accessible enrichment activities, whilst also providing them with a nutritious meal. The choice of activities is designed to develop participants' resilience, character, and wellbeing along with their wider educational attainment.

The HAF programme is delivered in Wiltshire using the brand FUEL (Food, Unity, Energy, Laugher) and the programme is a direct response to the growing issue of holiday hunger.

About the Role

We are looking for staff who are committed to making the school holidays an enriching experience for these children and are prepared to go the extra mile to achieve this.

The SEND specialist will work alongside the Camp Leader and Assistant Camp Leader to ensure the wellbeing of all participants by delivering a safe and engaging programme. As the SEND specialist it will be your responsibility to check care plans or notes relating to additional needs to ensure the supports needs are met. You will be advising the camp coaches about their young people participating with additional needs, guiding them on how to best deliver content to ensure it is inclusive for all.



Main Responsibilities

- Attend compulsory training.
- Familiarise yourself with any participant care plans or notes relating to their additional needs.
- Ensure that the support, pastoral, and safety needs of the children are met by advising the Camp Coaches about their participants who require additional support.
- Ensure all policies and procedures are followed and tasks are completed accurately throughout the programme. Such tasks include incident/accident and safeguarding reporting as well as risk assessments.
- Advise Camp Coaches on how best to deliver the assigned content in such a way that all participants in their team
 get the most out of each session.
- Step in and facilitate sessions when and if required to support Camp Coaches.
- Adhere to staff code of conduct and wear your uniform when on camp.

- Ability to adapt activities according to individual learning styles or requirements.
- Experience of building a positive rapport with children from a variety of cultural, economic and social backgrounds.
- Ability to inspire and motivate teams and individuals to help them achieve their potential.
- Excellent teamwork skills and ability to collaborate effectively with colleagues.
- Ability to be proactive and adaptable with the skills to think on your feet.
- Well organised with a responsible attitude to paperwork and record-keeping.
