

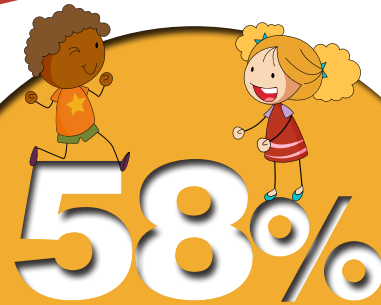

...from 900 primary school children in Derby inner city...



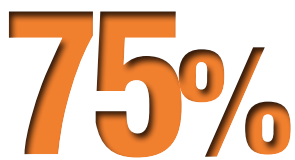
of children indicated their main influences of their job ideas were from family members.

The Interim Findings

From 226 Derby primary school teachers...

96%

would recommend the Our Future Derby programme

Career-related learning activities are having positive impacts on children including those most vulnerable.

Children are linking their schooling to the world of work.

The Interim Findings

From 86 volunteers...

81%

of volunteers stated the Our Future Derby programmes is "very worthwhile"

75%

of volunteers would accept further invitations to do this again



94%

rated the event they attended at least 8 out of a possible 10.
